*****New this year – Center closings will be listed on channel 3. *****

If the Enfield Schools are closed due to inclement weather, the center will be closed for the safety of our clients. If there is a delay in the Enfield Schools due to winter weather, check channel 3 to see if the center will be open or closed. If the center will be closing early due to a winter storm, you will be notified if the clients will be brought home early or will need to be picked up early.

Please have driveways and walkways shoveled and sanded for the safety of our clients and staff. During the inclement weather, it will be upon the discretion of the van driver and aide as to whether the driveway and walkway are safe for the client to be picked up in the van.
